

## **Temporary Deconstructions ~ Harm van den Dorpel ~ 2005**

Temporary Deconstructions is a series of short animations made by Harm van den Dorpel in which people, animals or things collapse and deform. They are 'moving-stills' where every animation is a reconfiguration of pieces of one single image. One source of inspiration worth mentioning is a short Christian propaganda film from 1941 called 'The Rapture'. The reason for the deconstructions could also be this apocalypse. However, in these animations, it never becomes entirely clear whether the actors have fainted, are living, dead, or sleeping; the pingpong-players continue to breathe when they lay on the ground.
